Carrie Holstein – Vocals

Carrie's father was a working musician and she grew up surrounded by music. Her first gig was at the age of 17 in a rock covers band called Calibre, she was then picked to audition for the very busy 70's cover band called Ultimate Freakout (UFO). In 1996 Carrie joined the heavy rock/grunge band called Zipper, they toured up and down the coast where they played some large outdoor venues. In 2005 Carrie worked with a trio/band called The Big Bang they played at many corporate events, weddings, and conferences. Carrie has a strong powerful voice and can adapt to any style of music.

Tony Rossi – Rhythm Guitar, Vocals

Tony began playing the Newcastle club and pub circuit in the early '70s. He has played in different bands and dabbled in different genres - even played the violin. But up front alongside Carrie is where you'll find him on stage with The Years and there's nowhere else he'd rather be. Tony is one of the founding members of Newcastle's iconic rock band from the '80s, Baron.

Rick Di Mecola – Lead Guitar, Vocals

Since High School, Rick was never far from his guitar, playing in various bands in Newcastle, even adding Baron's original lead guitarist to the list. After a brief hiatus from the stage, Rick continues to prove he knows his way around a guitar and, boy, can he sing.

Leo Della-Grotta – Bass, Vocals

Another Baron founding member, Leo started playing guitar in his younger years before quickly making the switch to bass in the late '70s – he has never looked back. Leo is part of The Years' tight rhythm section alongside Lelio, who together on bass and drums boast a long-playing history together. Not only is Leo the bass guitarist and back-up vocalist, he also manages to bring the laughs.

Lelio Rossi – Drums

Lelio hasn't been far from a drum kit since he was 12. Known as the driving force behind the band, he is one of the most energetic, hard-hitting drummers you're likely to find. His energy and passion for powerful drum solos is infectious. Lelio is also a founding member of Baron.

Ben Pettett - Keyboards, Vocals

Ben is a classically trained multi-instrumentalist who has played piano since the age of six and guitar from the age of 10. His musical talents in high school saw him tour Australia, England and Paris, and in his post-school years he played with several bands within the Newcastle area.
